

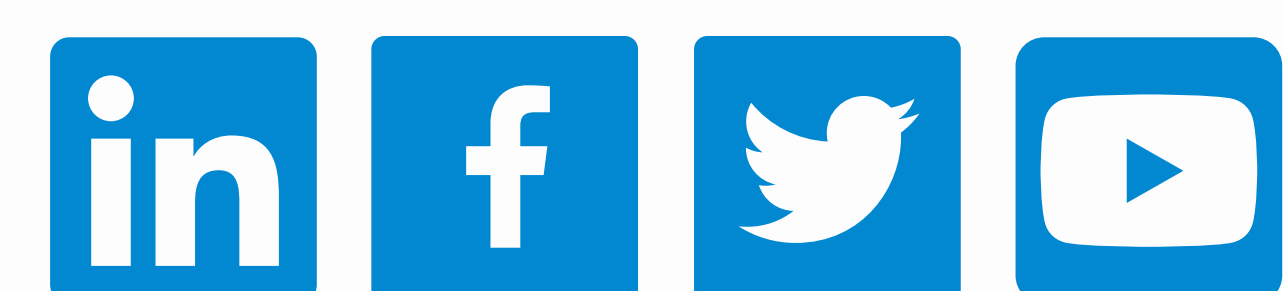

CONTENT RULES

Relevance

Our main goal is to provide valuable information to an audience interested in reading about project management. Our readers value well-researched content just like any other reader. Therefore, only articles that are relevant and authentic will be taken in consideration for publishing and for sharing on our social media profiles.

We advise all contributors to double-check their resources and submit content that contains well-researched data, supported by facts and arguments.

Originality

Each submitted article goes through a plagiarism checker. Unoriginal content is subject to rejection and content providers will subsequently be asked to rewrite and resubmit the article.

Third party quotes may be included, but only when linked to their appropriate sources.

Length and Formatting

Submitted articles should be more than 1500 words in length. It is advisable for contributors to write shorter, easily readable sentences and use active instead of passive voice.

Submitted articles should include a suggested headline and a short summary of the article (no longer than a few sentences). Articles should be easy to read, which is why we advise writers to break up the content into paragraphs headlined with subheadings. Adding headings and subheadings will increase the value of the article.

PMtips reserves the right to modify the suggested headlines, subheading and/or summaries to match the style of the site, all of which will be subject to final approval by the author before the official publishing of the article in question.

Tone of Voice

All articles should be written in first and/or second person. It is not recommended for contributors to submit writings in third person, unless the context of the content requires it.

Visuals

Visuals are meant to engage the audience and prompt them to read the article in full. Articles supported by images, videos or infographics will surely attract our readers. Therefore, we encourage contributors to include visuals in their article and use them as a tool to make it exciting.

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Contributors should include images that are only under CC0 1.0 Universal - Public Domain and provide us with the appropriate source and attribution for every image, video or infographic that is included in the article; otherwise, we reserve the right to use our own visuals when publishing the provided content.

Exclusivity

All submitted articles must be written exclusively for PMtips. We do not support the resubmitting of content already published on PMtips' site, on other websites and/or blogs.

The copyright of an article written for PMtips with the sole purpose of having it published on the site will be owned exclusively by PMtips. The author has no right to disseminate or publish their work written exclusively for PMtips, in whole or in part, nor any of its contents, on other websites or anywhere on the Internet, for which they will receive credit, but will lose all rights to its contents the moment the article is published on PMtips.

Linking

Links within article content are allowed only in cases when they are not placed with a promotional purpose and point to relevant and/or credible sources that will complement a reader's knowledge regarding a specific topic.

Our editors reserve the right to remove any links that are identified as promotional or seen as manipulative tactics for gaining direct visitors to third party sources and/or links that pass PageRank (an algorithm used by Google Search to rank web pages in their search engine results) or links that are placed with the intention to manipulate PageRank, and as such, may be considered to be a part of a link scheme.

Promotion

Proofreading and Editing

Please submit content that is in accordance with all previously stated rules. Our editors reserve the right to proofread and edit all submitted content if they find any language-related errors and/or inconsistency in regards to the length and format.

The author will be notified in case of any major changes; we will not publish articles without prior consultation with the author and without the author's consent. The author will not be notified in cases of minor corrections applied to the text.

Publication

Our editorial staff will make all final decisions with regards to the time of publishing the article. Making a submission request and/or providing us with an article will not guarantee its publication, for which the content provider will be notified accordingly. It is our practice to notify the author once the article is approved and published on the site.

AUTHORS' BIOGRAPHY

PMTips will credit the work of all authors that have articles published on our site. Therefore, we ask all authors to submit a short biography (100-200 words in length) when providing us with their first article.

Writing in the name of a company as well as adding links that lead to a blog or company websites and/or e-mail address, is prohibited.
